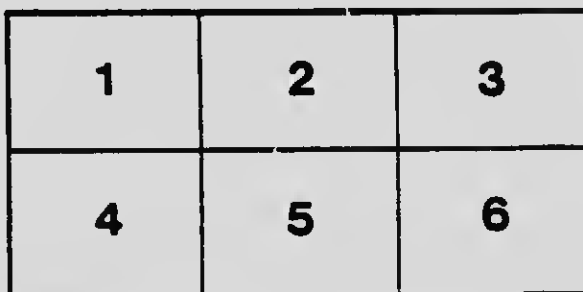
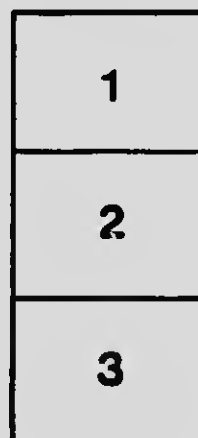

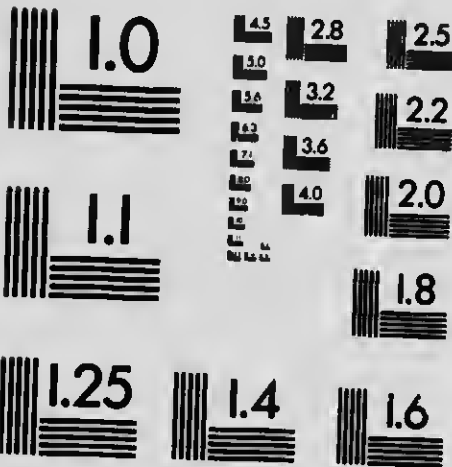

Alfred William Strutt was born in Taranaki, New Zealand. Received his art education under his father William Strutt, and at South Kensington, London, where he was awarded medals. He has exhibited much at the Royal Academy and is represented by work at the municipal art galleries of Wolverhampton, Burnley and Blackpool.

2. WINTER MORNING IN THE HIGHLANDS.....£220  
*A.K. Brown, R.S.A., R.B.C., R.I., R.S.W.*

Alexander Kellock Brown is a well-known Scottish landscape painter. Studied art at Glasgow School of Art with the intention of becoming a designer but abandoned it for landscape painting. He exhibits much at the Royal Academy, the Royal Scottish Academy, in Paris and Munich.

3. THE SEASONS.....£110

St. George Hare was born in Limerick. Studied at South Kensington. Hon. A.R.C.A.

4. THE JAFFA GATE, JERUSALEM.....£138

"This is the gate through which General Allenby passed on the surrender of the city."

Percy R. Craft. Born in London. Received art education at South Kensington, Heatherley's, and Slade School, under Sir E. J. Poynter and Professor Legros. Was elected a member of the Royal Society of British Artists, but later resigned. Resided for many years in the Newlyn Art Colony. A frequent exhibitor at the Royal Academy of Arts, the Salon Paris, the New Gallery, and the principal provincial exhibitions. Has a work acquired by the Grahamstown Art Gallery. Is a gold and silver medallist.

*W. Follen Bishop, R.B.A., R.B.C., R.C.A.*

Walter Follen Bishop, a painter of English landscape and rural country life. Art education at Liverpool and Paris at the Atelier Julian under Professors W. A. Bouguereau and Tony Robert Fleury. Works of his have been acquired for the Welsh Museum of Arts, Cardiff, the municipal permanent collection, Liverpool, Pietermaritzburg, South Africa, and the South Australian National Gallery.

*Julius Ollson, R.A., P.R.O.I., R.B.C.*

Julius Ollson. Born in London. His art education was self acquired and he was for many years a well-known member of the artist colony of St. Ives in Cornwall. Many of his works have been acquired for public galleries including Winnipeg Gallery permanent collection. Is a gold medallist and *hors concours* Paris Salon.

Fred Milner. Born in Yorkshire. Studied at the Slade School. Is represented by important works in the Corporation Art Gallery, Preston, and National Museum, Buenos Ayres. Was elected a member of the Royal Society of British Artists, but afterwards resigned.

Stanhope Alexander Forbes. Born at Dublin. Art education at the Lambeth School of Arts, the Royal Academy Schools, and at the Atelier Bonnat, Paris. Is generally recognized as the pioneer of the "Plein Air" school of painting in England, of which his picture, "A Fish Sale on a Cornish Beach" was probably the first. A well-known member of the artists' colony of Newlyn in Cornwall. Is represented by works in most of the provincial public galleries, and a picture of his was purchased under the Chantrey bequest. Is a corresponding member of the Institute de France.

Was awarded a medal at the Barcelona International Art Exhibition and is a frequent exhibitor at the Royal Academy of Arts, the Salon, Paris, the Royal Glasgow Institute, Royal Institute of Painters in Water Colors, and other prominent exhibitions.

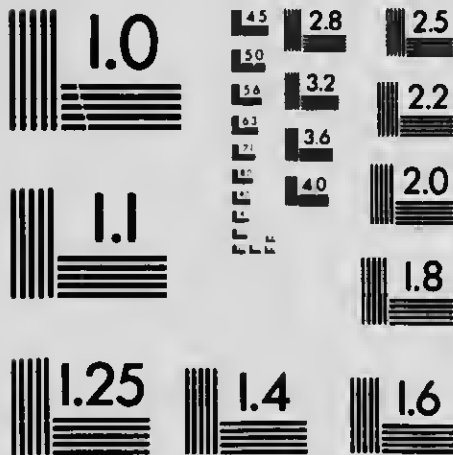
